## **Description:**

LD7000A is a Low Density Polyethylene produced by High Pressure technology. LD7000A is intended for the manufacturing of extruded films. It has high mechanical and impact strength, good processability, and good shrinkage.

### Additivation:

Heavy-duty bags; agriculture, coextruded and shrink films; blow molding; tubes and hoses.

#### **Process:**
